

Precautions for Using the Facility

- Both players and observers must wear indoor footwear inside this facility.
- In case you want to withdraw from your match, please make contact with the tournament headquarter as soon as possible. 080-3150-0494 (available during the tournament, Tournament Director Sano)
- Please be aware that lost items will be disposed of after 1 week from the tournament.
- No Food except in the designated area. Thanks for keeping the facility clean.
- Please separate and throw away your trash by following the directions in the facility.

Precautions during Matches

- In case you cannot enter the court on time, you shall be withdrawn from your match automatically.
- Main matches and each plate finals will be played “best of 5” games match with “PER11” tie-break system. All of the plate matches except finals will be played “best of 3” games match.
- Please be a Referee (winner) or a Marker (loser) after your match. (Please make contact with the tournament headquarter if you can't.)
- 5-minute warm-ups will be allowed before 5 games matches. 3- minute warm-ups will be allowed before 3 games matches. (Usually 5 minutes for both cases, but not this time)
- Players must wear eye-guards approved by WSF during matches(Allowed to wear eye-guards approved by WSF in 2012 at this time)
- Please be aware and prepared that your scheduled match may be brought forward as the tournament runs smoothly.
- Stay cool and hydrated as very hot temperatures expected during the tournament. Please be prepared and take safety measures.

Plate Matches

- Plate matches will be played by players who lost in the 1st or 2nd rounds.
 - Consolation plate matches will be played by players who lost in the 1st or 2nd rounds in the plate matches.
 - Classic plate matches will be played by players who lost in the quarter finals.
- *Except Boys and Girls U11 and Girls U19

Commendation Ceremony

- The commendation ceremony will take place on August 4th after all matches are played (Around 5:30pm).
- 1st ~ 3rd place winners of Finals and 1st place winners of each plate matches will be awarded.

Notification from PR

Please be aware that photos will be taken during the tournament only for the purpose of PR activities of Japan Squash Association (JSA). If any player does not agree to be updated on JSA website or anywhere else, please make contact with the tournament headquarter.

Matters with Personal Filming and Photography

Please be aware that no photography and filming may take place except for the persons concerned with players on the courts. In such cases, please don't forget to ask opponent players or guardians for permission. It may happen that these activities would be stopped by Tournament Director when other people complain of them, or these activities take place without regard to moral principles in general.
